Getting from the airport

The best way to get to Moscow from Sheremetyevo, Domodedovo and Vnukovo airports is high-speed **aeroexpress** train: aeroexpress.ru. Alternative ways are suburban trains, buses, public taxi buses or taxi. It's easier to call a taxi in Moscow using the applications of the largest companies: Yandex.Taxi, City-Mobile, Gett or Uber Russia. If you are arriving at the airport at night, you can take a night bus: Sheremetyevo – H1, Domodedovo – No. 308, Vnukovo – H11.

Carsharing

Carsharing in Moscow is convenient and not expensive at all. All it takes is to download an operator app to your smartphone from AppStore or PlayMarket, enter registration details and wait for confirmation. The biggest carsharing companies are Yandex.Drive, YouDrive, Belka-Car, MatryoshCar and Delimobil.

Bikesharing

You do not have to walk in Moscow, you can enjoy sights and keep in trim renting a bicycle. Register in the bicycle rental system with Velobike application, at the station terminal or at velobike.ru, pay for the rental by card and you are ready to go! Daily access will cost only 150 roubles. After paying for access, you can ride as many times as you like up to 30 minutes at no extra charge. You can take a bicycle at one parking place and leave it at any other, and it is easy to find such parking places in the city.

River cruises

You can take a boat ride through the centre of Moscow at any time of the year even in winter – navigation on the Moscow River lasts 365 days a year. Excursion rides on ice-class yachts with a restaurant on board or on river cabriolets of the Radisson Royal Flotilla (radisson-cruise.ru) will allow you to see the capital from a different angle. Boat rides start every 30 minutes from 8 wharfs. There are performance and gastronomic cruises, animation for children on weekends.

Sightseeing Bus

To see the sights of the city, you can buy a ticket to the famous CitySightseeing double-decker (city-sightseeing.ru). Through the window or from the roof of the double-decker you will see the main and the most interesting things in the city and will certainly listen to the story about Moscow sights in your native language with a multi-language audio guide. The hop on – hop off system allows to get off and on the bus where you wish, and as often as you need.

Cable way

If you happen to be on Vorobyovy Gory, do not miss memorable experience of the cable way (srkvvg.ru) connecting the observation site with Luzhniki stadium. The cabin is swinging smoothly in the wind, like a bird moving its centre of gravity from one wing to another. With the help of media screens and an audio guide in 4 languages, you can find out a lot of interesting things, including the history of the construction of the metro bridge, which is best seen from here. Exit to the take-off runway passes through different ends of Vorobyovy Gory Metro station.

Metro Tours

The Moscow metro is not only one of the main objects of transport infrastructure, but also an underground museum, and of course a destination for various excursions. Here you will walk through beautiful stations, 44 of which are recognized as cultural heritage sites, and will get to know rare and hidden chapters of history. It is quite easy to get such an excursion: visit the site tour.mosmetro.ru and choose the topic, time and date that suit you. All the most interesting excursions in the Metro can be found at one place.

The Gorky Park is 250 hectares of pure recreation at a picturesque bank of the Moskva river. In 2014 **Neskuchny Garden**, nature reserve **Vorobyovy Gory** and green areas of Moscow State University were integrated into the Gorky Park, and it became the favourite destination for recreation and walks with children.

The huge **Salyut playground** complies with the new dimensions of the park. It is the biggest play structure in Russia: nine spaces for games with sand, water, colour, sound, height and depth, various pat-

terns, forms and sizes. There is a unique Mega swing ground – 29 swings with all possible types of rotation. The ground is adapted for children with various disabilities.

From April till September **Peoples observatory** is open. Here you can view at daytime the Sun, the Moon and Venus.

On weekdays kindergarten Thinking. Individuality. Development (MIR) is open in Muzeon. In summer MIR operates as a children camp (open from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.). In other seasons children also have enough to stay busy: language courses, programming, pain-



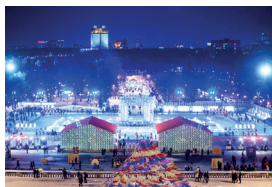

ting, vocal and music classes, pottery. Chess club Belaya Ladya (White Rook) is open daily in Neskuchny Garden.

City Cottage Zelenaya Shkola (Green School) is open all year round. It has a nursery (0+) – a light and cosy space, where children can play all year round supervised by parents and school employees, – and a school (6+) offering classes in ecology, gardening, art master classes. The traditional Russian dacha has been reconstructed here: an orchard, a kitchen garden, a samovar and a round table, on which the guests play board games, drink tea and listen to fairy tales.

In summer, boating stations are operating on the Pionersky and Golitsynsky park ponds.

The Main entrance arch houses the Park History Museum, an observation deck with a panoramic view of the park and Moscow, a lecture hall and a souvenir shop. Leaving the park, do not forget to drop in it.

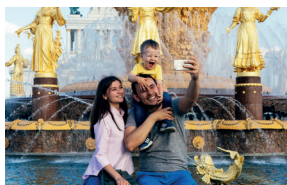

Present day children often ask the question: how did they live in the USSR? This is the best place to get to know the USSR from its most attractive side and show it to children. **VDNH** (The Exhibition of Achievements of National Econ-

omy) is the dream town organized in 1939 as the embodiment of the bright future. Now it is a sort of retro-utopia, a museum of the USSR history. For example, in pavilion No. 57 Russia is my history, with the main exposition dedicated to the history of the Russian state system, you will find the **Museum of Soviet game machines (6+)**. Time seems to have stopped there: to play the machines costs 15 cents, and a glass of Soviet soda costs, as in the post-war USSR, three cents. However, time flows on. Extensive reconstruction is underway. VDNH is

a beautiful, living, green park, with a few excellent museums and some pavilions of celestial beauty. VDNH does not freeze in the past and is developing simultaneously in several lines that gradually take their spatial form. Educational zone (mainly in the right wing from the main entrance) includes pavilions No. 34 the **Astronautics and aviation Centre**, No. 36 **Cinema Museum**, No. 461 **Smart City**. Interactive zone, where you can engage in interesting and useful activities: building No. 174a **Caramel manufactory**, pavilion No. 47 **House of Crafts**, **Technograd** and others. Landscape park has five natural zones, eco-systems, the Labyrinth. Of special note is the **City Farm**. In the latter you can not only take a look at cows and listen to bleating of sheep and goats, but also have a walk with a donkey and caress an alpaca (lama).

Sometimes one lacks sea in Moscow. The active oceanarium at VDNH successfully compensates for this drawback. **Moskvarium** is equipped up to the latest advances in ocean science and technology. Visitors can see over 8 thousand species of fishes and pinniped. There are seven pools for swim-



ming with dolphins. The building is divided into the area for aquariums and water shows and the centre of swimming with dolphins. In the lower floor there are 80 aquariums with over 600 species of fishes and animals, including killer whales, dolphins, walruses, sharks, electric rays, crocodiles, etc. In the aquarium area there is a contact

pool, where visitors can touch marine amphibians. You will hardly have another chance to touch an electric ray.

VDNH is a beautiful, living, green park, with a few excellent museums and pavilions of celestial beauty

Beside the interactive museum complex of reusable space shuttle Buran there is **Cosmos playground** with game models of spaceships and rocket-shaped hills.

On the right from VDNH Central Alley, near McDonald's, there is a **ground adapted for children with special needs**.

Lunch at a children's **Anderson Na Dache Café** will not only satisfy your hunger, it will bring you and your children joy and pleasure.

The name Sokolniki comes from the Russian word "falcon" and is related to tsar falconry practiced in this forest from the 15th century. Even today Sokolniki is the edge of the vast forest in the North-East of Moscow. In 1931 Sokolniki Grove got the status of a city park. However, the forest essence of Sokolniki did not disappear.

Here you can meet not only squirrels and forest birds. Elks continue to live here in their natural environment. If you are lucky, you can observe them from a short distance.

But not only animals – people feel good in Sokolniki too. A cascade of ponds, a resort of wild nature in the heart of the city is a point of attraction. At **Putyaevskie ponds** there is an equipped camping zone with visitor parking, electricity, sanitary zone, children playground and sports area.

Children love Sokolniki. The main thing they find here – **Children's Creativity Centre** with hobby groups like painting, ship modelling, photography, chess, etc.

Children and teenagers who always loved Sokolniki fell in even stronger love to the park after opening of Pioneer open air summer cinema operating from May to October, movie time only in the evening, the program including latest releases, festival hits, classics and special shows. The project is supported by French embassy,

Besides, in the park territory there are lots of sports and playgrounds, including **Emerald City** – a ground for children with disabilities, hills, merry-go-round and swings, shooting ranges, skate park, trampoline stage and **FunGrad** rope park. **FunGrad** is also a car town, where driving electronic cars is combined with learning traffic rules.

Old Izmailovsky park, the former estate of boyars and later – the Romanovs, the Russian tsar dynasty, is divided into two unequal parts: natural and historic part and cultural part. The huge forest park is a favorite place for lovers of nature and healthy lifestyle enthusiasts. There are walks, runs, trainings,

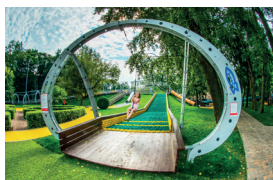
ponds, trails, birds, squirrels. (And if you are lucky, you will see bunnies in the park, too). In summer, you can also sunbathe on the banks of the picturesque pond or the Serebryanka river. The forest park is especially good in the morning when it is deserted. The territory of Izmailovsky Park is traditionally divided in the Northern and Central parts. The Northern part is known for Zabava amusement area and bow and cross-bow shooting range. The main attraction of the Central part is the Round pond in the form of a horseshoe with a boating station (operating in summer in good weather). Perhaps, here you will also be interested in the ancient European games on the multi-platform, for example, the Bavarian Eystock or the game of

American Indians – Cornhall. In winter, do not miss the chance to visit the Silver Ice rink. It is 11,000 sq. m of ice and about the same amount of pure enjoyment.

Bauman garden was made up of a few manor gardens of 18th – 19th centuries. There is a big playground for children with swings and one of the best CityKids children centres. It will be comfortable here for people with disabilities. Children's theatre Funny Bell House is open all year round.

Delegate park is the territory of the former theological seminary, and today in its monks' cells you will find children studios and hobby groups. The atmosphere of the park is created by century-old trees, planted by seminarians, and a slope with an extreme descent, which in winter turns into an ice hill adored by the children.

Red Presnya Park is a symbol of the garden art of the 18th – 19th centuries on the grounds of the country estate of the princes Gagarins, who founded a system of picturesque Dutch ponds with islands and arched bridges. Children and their mothers love the park for its compact size.

Some Moscow residents still remember the competition of the two Moscow circuses – the old and the new ones: which one is better? **The Big Moscow Circus** was more modern, the smaller one in Tsvetnoy boulevard was cosier. Today the Circus on Vernadskogo avenue, on the contrary, is already old, and **Nikulin Circus** is relatively new. Both are better. Besides seeing the performance, one can make an excursion and take a look from inside how the circus mechanism is operating.

The new circus today is the **circus of animal tamers Zapashny brothers**. It uses modern scenery, costumes, light. The brothers write fantasy scripts. But the key point here is certainly staggering animal acts.

In **Durov's Corner** (grandfather Durov, as Muscovites call him lovingly), everything is by contrast very conservative. However, for each new generation of children, performances remain as fresh and surprising as in the last century. In the Durov's theatre you can see animals among the artists normally considered to be ineducable – foxes, racoons, birds and even common mice.

The Obraztsov Puppet Theatre is the biggest puppet theatre in the world founded in 1931. It has a unique Museum of Theatre Puppets, where famous puppets from the whole world are collected. Metal clock on the theatre facade is the brand identity of not only the theatre, but of the city too.

RAMT (Russian Academic Youth Theatre) is not just for children, it is for all generations. Earlier called the Central Children's Theatre, it is now a young, sincere, popular experimental theatre.

The Youth Theatre was organized in 1920 and was called the First State Theatre for Children. Since late 1980s it is headed by Henrietta Yanovskaya, whose staging of *The Heart of a Dog*, written by M. A. Bulgakov, made the theatre globally known.

In one of the oldest European Zoos that extended over a huge territory of 26 ha, animals feel very well, and people do too. The conditions are adapted to the animals' natural habitat. It is a place where we can support and preserve rare endangered species of animals. As a result, **Moscow Zoo** is a participant of the program to preserve and study giant pandas (or cat bears), which is Chinese

endemic listed in Red Book. In the legal sense, all giant pandas in the world are property of China. They are sent for temporary housing under the program of preservation, protection and study of giant panda, and their offspring is returned to China at the age of 4 years. Gifting pandas is always a political gesture and is called panda diplomacy. For instance, the first panda was gifted in the USSR in 1957 within this political initiative. Return of these animals to the exposition for an unprecedented term – 15 years – has become the pinnacle event in the year of the 155th anniversary of Moscow Zoo.

The Zoo is divided into the old and the new territories. The old one has elephant enclosure with a two-storied viewing deck. In its ground floor there is an interactive **Elephant museum**, where children will get to know the character and habits of the

biggest animal and will have a chance to touch its trunk and tusks. You will see plenty of wild cats here, for example fast cheetah. Opposite to cheetah enclosure you will find a big **Giraffe House**, above which in the oldest Zootopia building the **Museum of Moscow Zoo History** is located. There you can touch its history that starts from 1864, get to know how animals survived historical disasters of the 20th century and how people helped them to survive. One more interesting pavilion is **Birds world**, where friendly penguins meet you at the entrance. In the dolphinarium

you can watch performances of dolphins and Arctic whales. The kings of the new territory of the Zoo are white bears. It is here that the **Primates House** with thirty species of apes is located. **Reptile house** unfailingly arouses intense interest. Whether the alligator that looks like dead would open its jaws?

The territory is huge, and you will need a whole day to see all enclosures and pavilions, and perhaps not a single day. But if your children get tired, there are lots of benches around. You can enter Moscow Zoo through the main entrance or through the New territory from Bolshaya Gruzinskaya street or from the Garden Ring.

In Moscow planetarium you will feel the sky coming closer. The building of the Planetarium has three levels. The Big Star Hall is located directly under the dome, at the other levels there is Small Star Hall, 4D cinema, Moonarium interactive museum, and two observatories with real telescopes. The planetarium is a unique combination of happiness by learning and relaxation.

Cosmos Pavilion is probably the most outstanding structure in the VDNH by its size, engineering and architecture. It is one of the summits of Stalin's Empire style and of the Soviet art of the 30s-50s in general. The display area of Cosmos consists of three sections. CB-1. Cosmic boulevard is dedicated to the astronautic achievements of the 20th century. Visitors can see model rockets, satellites and giant jet engines. The most interesting exhibits are a 30-ton model of Mir space station in 1:1 scale, Soyuz landing capsule and a carrier rocket. Section CB-2. Construction Bureau tells the visitors about scientific developments in astronautics, including biology. This part of the pavilion looks like a laboratory from Hollywood movies. CB-3. Cosmodrome of the Future is dedicated to the future and entertaining science fiction. You can play scientific game machines or visit Space sphere, a 5D cinema. One of the best features is interactivity of some space station models. Cosmos Pavilion stirs up interest to the subject and pride for the achievements of the Russian science and of the mankind in general.

Branch of the Polytechnical Museum at VDNH is a temporary exposition, since Moscow Polytechnical Museum is under reconstruction till 2020. The exhibition is divided into seven sections, each with its main exhibit. These are sections dedicated to nuclear energy, medicine, radio engineering, and electricity. The most extraordinary thing in this pavilion is not what is displayed, but how it is displayed – vividly and by contrast. Each lamp looks like a work of art. Polytech is interactive. Among other interactive installations there is an electronic model of the Big Bang that can be viewed forward and back. The highlight of the show is a life-sized model of the first nuclear bomb. If you press the button you will hear a loud siren of a nuclear alarm.

There are a few trampoline parks in Moscow. Each of them has its advantages. **Nebo** (Sky) trampoline centre is the biggest in the city. A single entrance ticket allows you to visit

not just trampolines, but also a climbing wall, rope park, etc. **Nevesomost** (Zero Gravity) adds a play element: entertainers can dress up as famous characters: Jack the Sparrow or Iron Man. **Cosmos** (Space) trampoline centre has affordable entry price and is known for its pleasant and friendly atmosphere. **Gravitatsia** (Gravity) is a big sports complex with a fitness centre, a sauna, a swimming pool, a climbing wall, a trampoline centre, a skate park, and a roofed wake park (the biggest swimming pool in Moscow – 70 m). GravityKids school covers all these lines of activities. During school holidays GravityCamp welcomes children in the centre.

Sky Town high-level rope park is a 16 m high structure in the VDNH territory. It includes 90 exciting elements and routes, giant swings with the amplitude of 16 meters, as well as children parkour ground.

Panda Park rope attractions (3+) are open in all big parks and many districts of the capital. While roofed rope attractions are active all year round, the street ones – only in summertime in good weather. Each park has a few routes that you can choose individually or combine into a bigger route.

The smaller building of GUM is located opposite to the main building across Vetoshny pereulok. It is logical that it was chosen for **Children's GUM**, claiming to be the main children's store in Moscow. It offers not so much toys, clothes and bicycles, as the very atmosphere of childhood. In a famous Soviet cartoon from the 80s there is song "Clouds, white-maned horses" with a special spirit that they tried to create here. Blue heavens, white fluffy clouds soaring under the ceiling, colourful balloons, child cars that you may drive over the whole store. Children love it here, and parents regress to childhood for some time.

In the USSR **Children's World** was just a store. Today the **Central Kids Store on Lubyanka** means something more. First, it is a unique structure, restored in its original appearance. Take a note of unique giant clock with a pendulum in the central hall. It is one of the 5 biggest mechanical clocks in the world. Each floor of **CDM** is a special world with interactive zones for children. And sure, there is Museum of Childhood in the top floor, with toys and goods sold in the store in 60s-90s of the past century. At the same time, it is a comfortable and stylish shopping center, where you can have the time of your life, especially for young couples who have re-

cently parted from their childhood. Busy with shopping, do not miss the main point of interest of the present-day **Central Kids Store on Lubyanka**. There is an open-air observation deck on the roof of the building with excellent views on the Kremlin, as well as the south and the west of Moscow.
